# Gail Benjamin Fellowship



In 2006 the IAF established the Gail Benjamin Fellowship in honor of the late Gail Benjamin, a strong and tireless advocate in the field of career education. Gail strongly believed in the necessity and responsibility of each generation to offer their skills and talents in assisting future generations in fulfilling their educational and career goals.

The Gail Benjamin Fellowship offers grants to females and minorities to attend the Career College Association (CCA) Leadership Institute. CCA sponsors this annual seminar, which is designed for existing and emerging career college directors. The 2009 Leadership Institute will be held at the Bolger Center in Potomac, MD from July 16-21, 2009. The Gail Benjamin Fellowship provides up to \$2,700 in grants to cover the cost of the Leadership Institute seminar, which includes tuition, lodging, and meals. All nominations must be received by **May 29, 2009**.

### Applicant Qualifications:

- Must be female or minority working professionals at a CCA member college;
- Must obtain a written nomination from their college campus president;
- Must have a minimum of three years employment at their current career college;
- Must demonstrate financial need;
- Must demonstrate high potential, strong commitment to, and aptitude for longevity within the career college sector;
- Must demonstrate involvement through voluntary service to their career college and/or local community; and
- Must include a copy of their resumé or curriculum vitae with their application.
